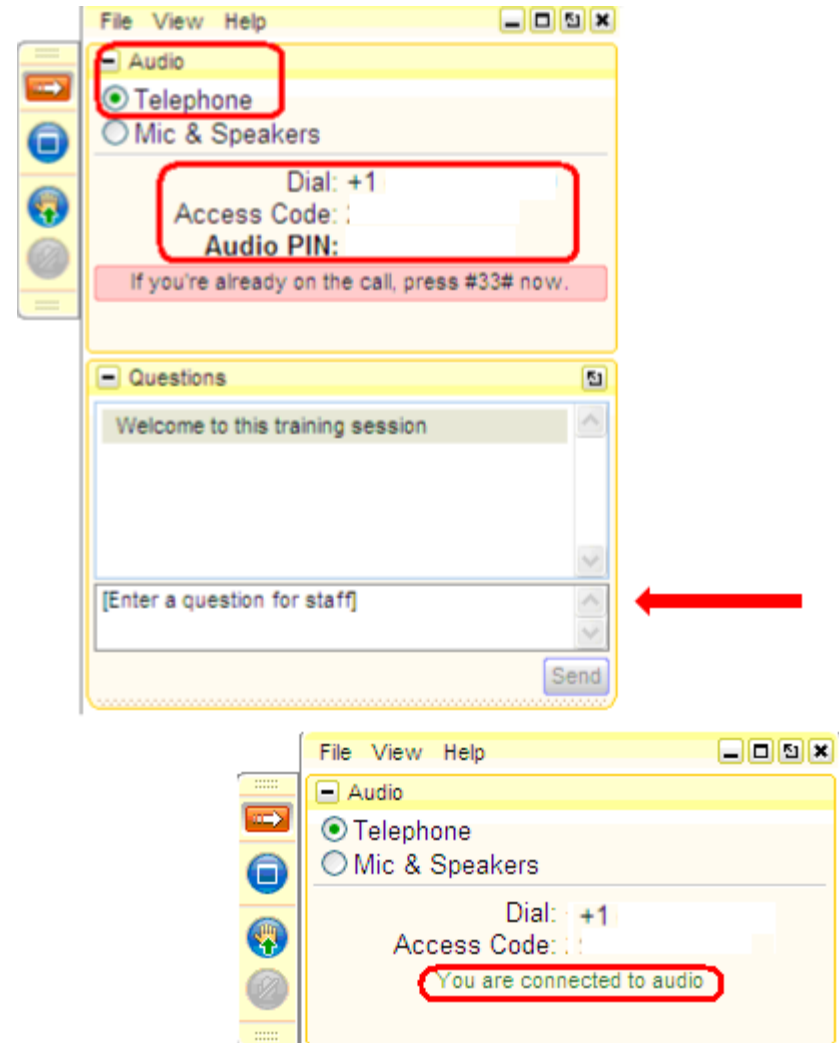

Using the Webinar Tool Bar

- Webinar tool bar
 - Be sure that you have indicated the telephone option and entered the PIN.
 - It should say “You are connected to audio”
 - This will allow us to hear you ask questions
- Questions can be typed in the questions section



Using the Webinar Tool Bar

- If you have a question, click on the hand icon with the green arrow – it will turn red indicating that your hand is raised.



- Click the icon again to lower your hand if your question is answered – the arrow should now appear green.

Checking the Crosswalk

CEDI recommends verifying your NPI and PTAN are linked on the crosswalk before completing enrollment forms. A crosswalk is the link established between the NPI and DME PTAN (Supplier ID). Verify your link using the tool below.

Locating the Edit Information

- Locate your error codes in the STC segment or reported on your acknowledgement file.

Examples:

STC*A7:562:85**U*1983~

STC*A8:562:85**U*1983*
*****A8:128:85

STC*A7:507**U~

STC*A7:453**U~

277CA Edit Tool

Understanding the Codes

There are 3 types of codes returned in the STC segment:

- Claim Status Category Code (CSCC)
- Claim Status Codes (CSCs)
- Entity Identifier Code (EIC)

Not all of these types of codes will be returned in all edit rejections.

Example 1:

STC*A7:562:85U*1983~**

A7 = CSCC

562 = CSC

85 = EIC

Example 2:

STC*A8:562:85U*1983**
****A8:128:85**

A8 = CSCC

562 = CSC

128 = CSC

85 = EIC

277CA Edit Lookup Tool

The 277CA Edit Tool allows suppliers, Trading Partners, billing services, and clearinghouses to view easy-to-understand descriptions associated with the edit code(s) returned on the 277CA – Claim Acknowledgement for 5010 claims. The tool allows the supplier to enter the Claim Status Category Code (CSCC), the Claim Status Codes (CSCs), and the Entity Identifier Code (EIC) for the edit and return the possible explanations for the cause of the edit.

Top Edits Seen By CEDI

- A3:247 – Line Information
 - Entire claim rejected for an error on one of the charge lines
 - Error will need to be corrected and entire claim resent
 - Additional error codes and charge line information should be provided to help determine the rejection cause

Top Edits Seen By CEDI

- A7:507 – HCPCS
 - Caused by the procedure code or modifier combination being invalid
- Steps to Take
 - Verify the HCPCS is valid for the date of service
 - Verify the modifiers submitted are required
 - Verify that a modifier that was not included on the claim is required

Note: CEDI can not verify billing information.

DTP*472*D8*20120918~

SVC*HC:V2020:NU*150***1~**

STC*A7:507U~**

REF*FJ*00123~

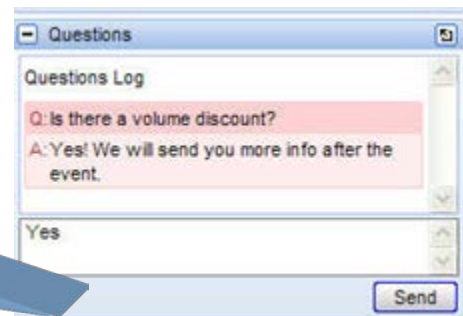


Hand Raised looks like this
